Financial Highlights

- › Consolidated Revenue at Rs 2,400 mn in Q1 FY24 grew by 15% QoQ and 17% YoY
 - › Hospital business Revenue at Rs.2,164 mn in Q1 FY24 grew by 18 % QoQ and 20% YoY
 - › Implant business Revenue at Rs.164 mn in Q1 FY24 de-grew by (21)% QoQ and (38)% YoY
- › Consolidated EBITDA at Rs.477 mn in Q1 FY24 grew by 37% QoQ and 8% YoY

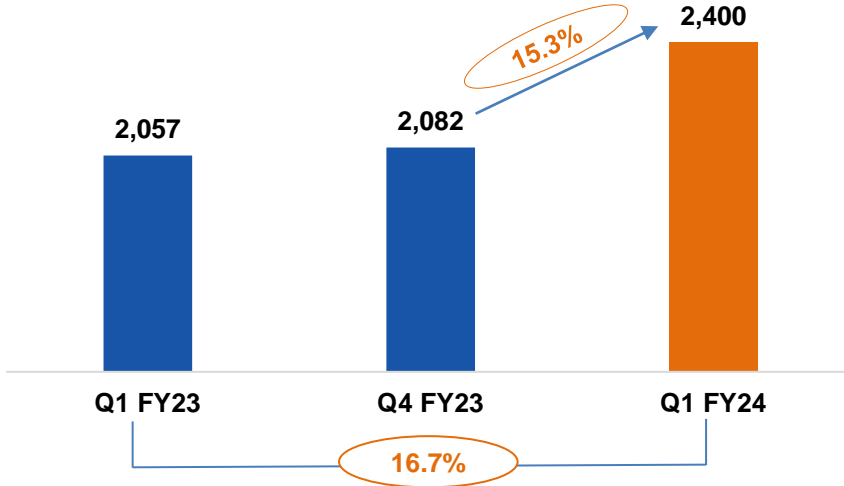

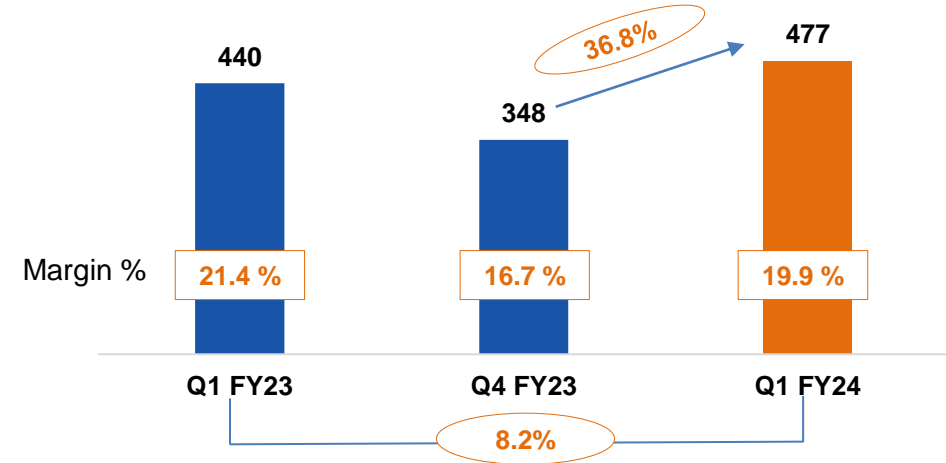

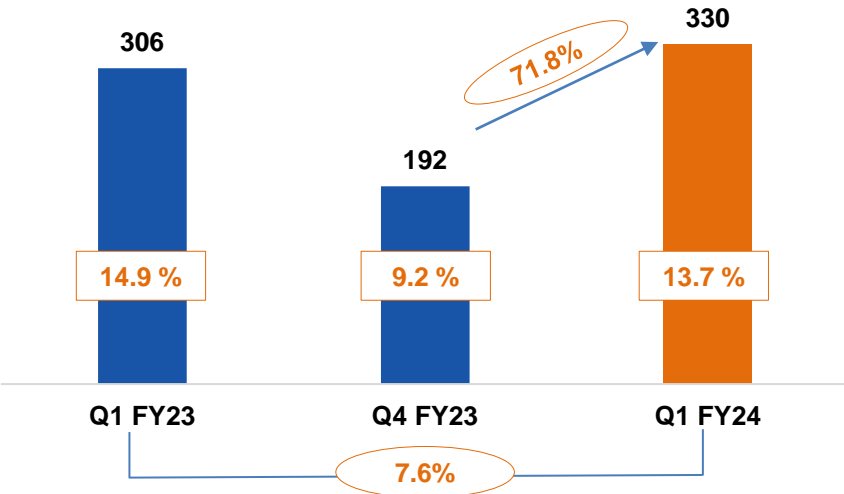
Revenue (INR MN)



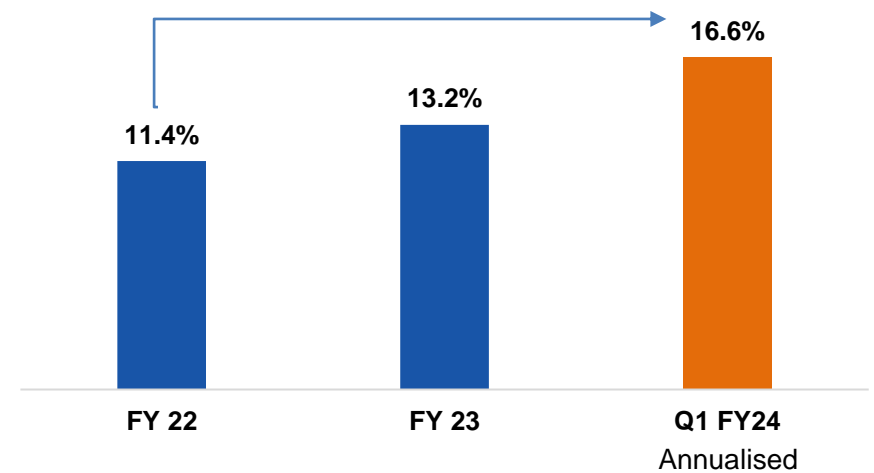

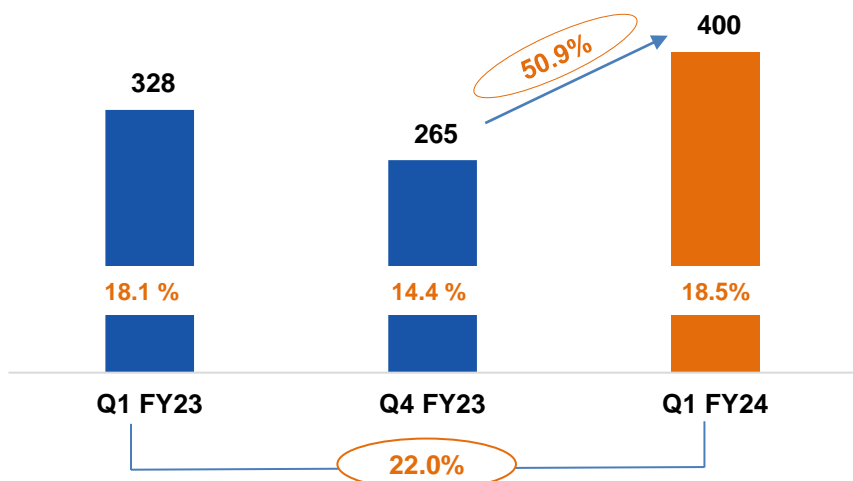

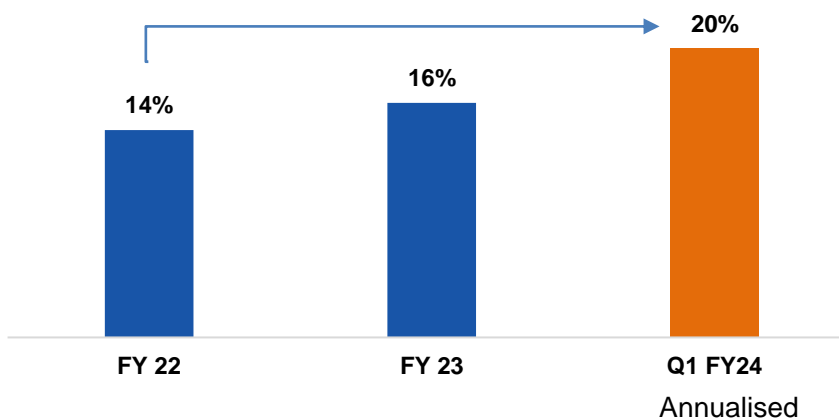

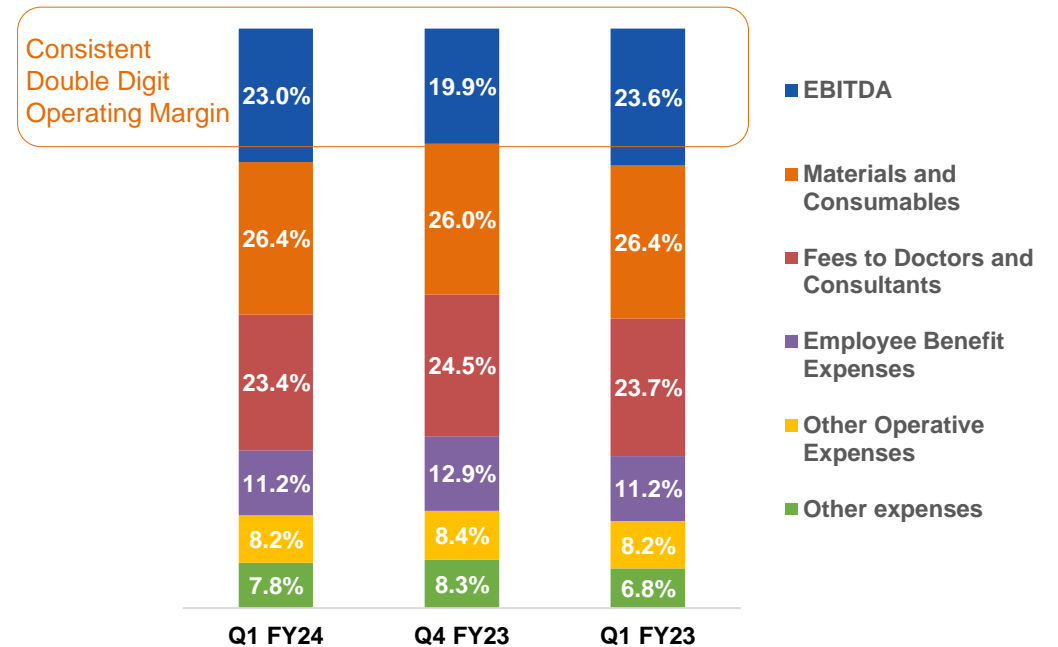

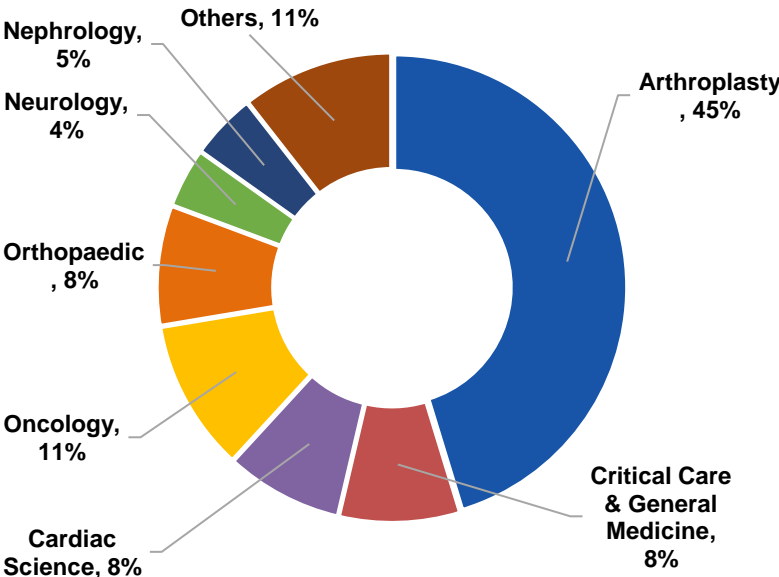

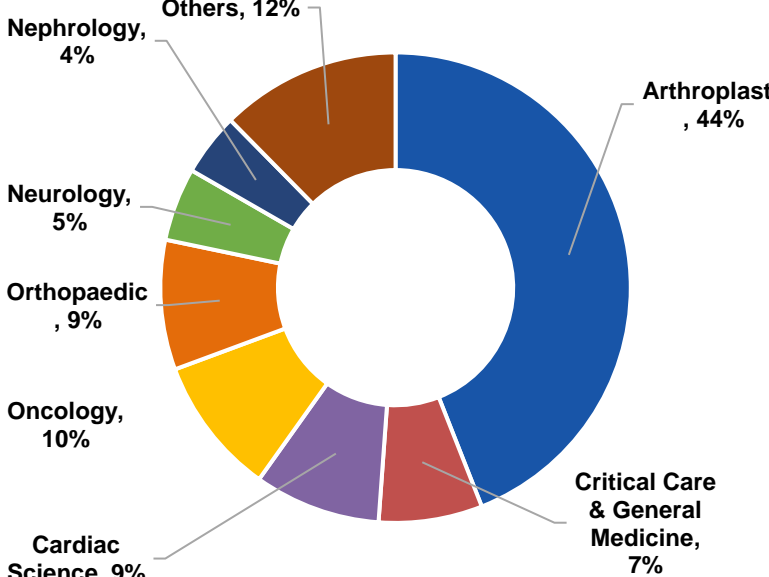

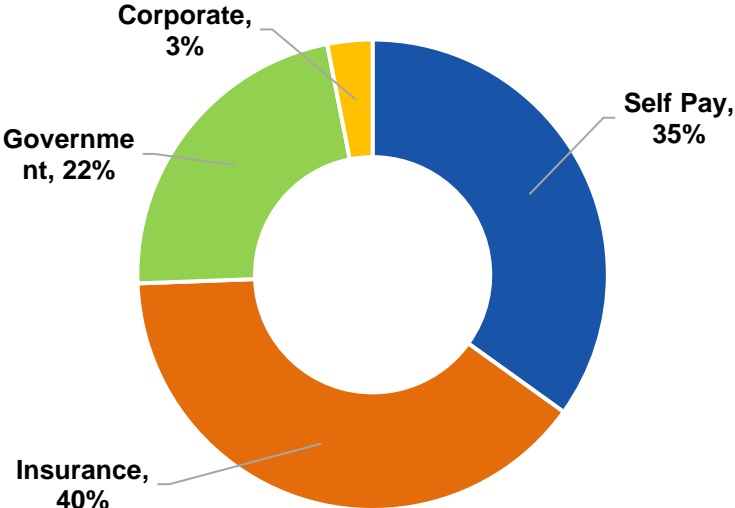

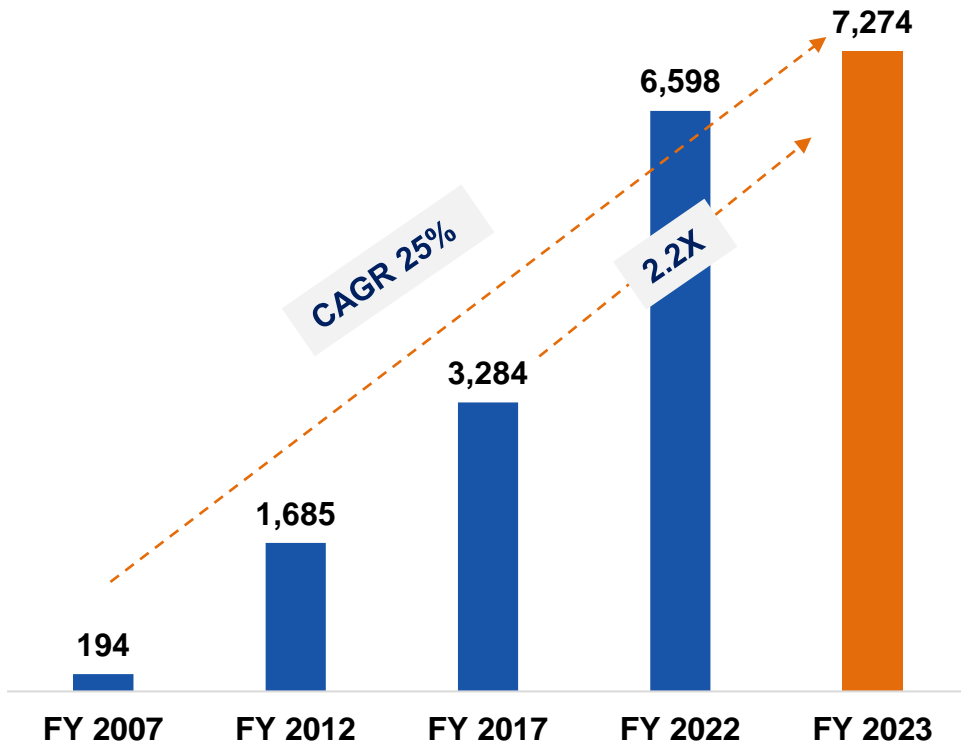

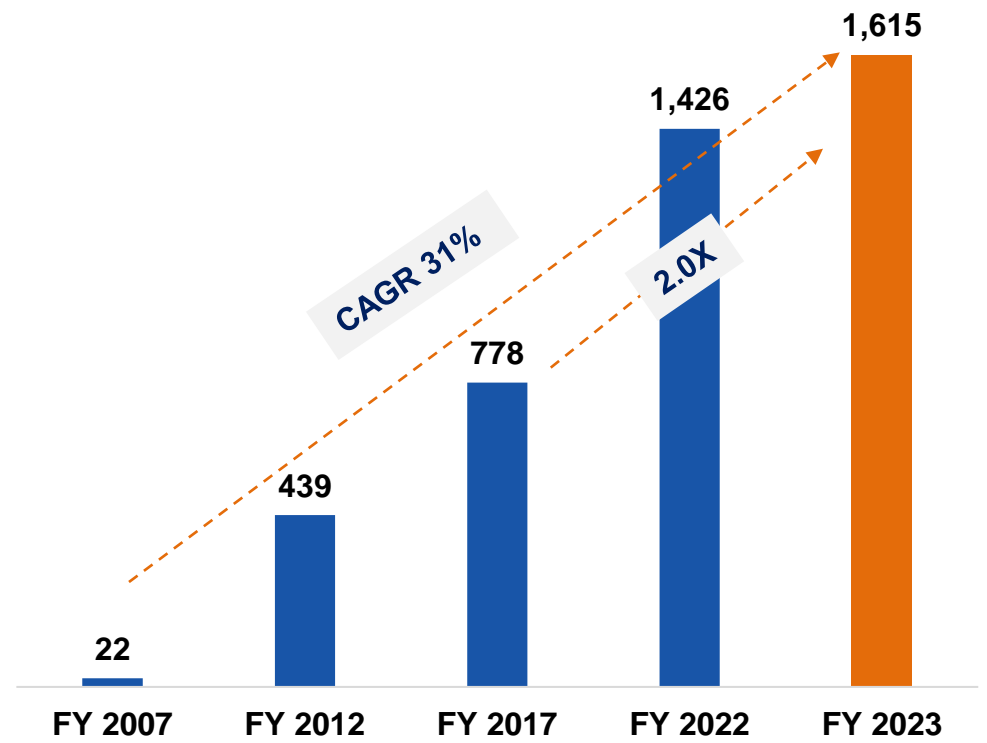

- 15 Transplants (10 Kidney and 5 Liver) in Q1 FY24 with this we have performed **250+** Transplants so far at our SG and Indore units
- Severely burn injury patient with damage to eyes treated successfully with embryotic membrane grafting in both eyes at Naroda Shalby Hospital.
- Heart tumour attached to heart valve removed with complete conservation of the valve at Shalby Hospital Indore (generally valve needs to be replaced in such cases).
- Kidney disease because of urinary flow obstruction treated successfully with challenging surgery at Shalby Hospital Surat.
- At Shalby Hospital Jaipur a novel device, Micra AV leadless pacemaker, implanted in a patient who had infection in previously implanted pacemaker. Micra is the world's smallest pacemaker, and, unlike conventional pacemakers, it does not contain any wire.
- Microvascular decompression of Trigeminal Nerve performed with Minimal Invasive approach
- **~17 clinical trials** are currently underway across all hospital units and 3 clinical trials are closed during Q1 FY24

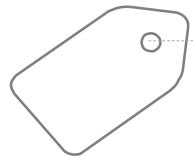

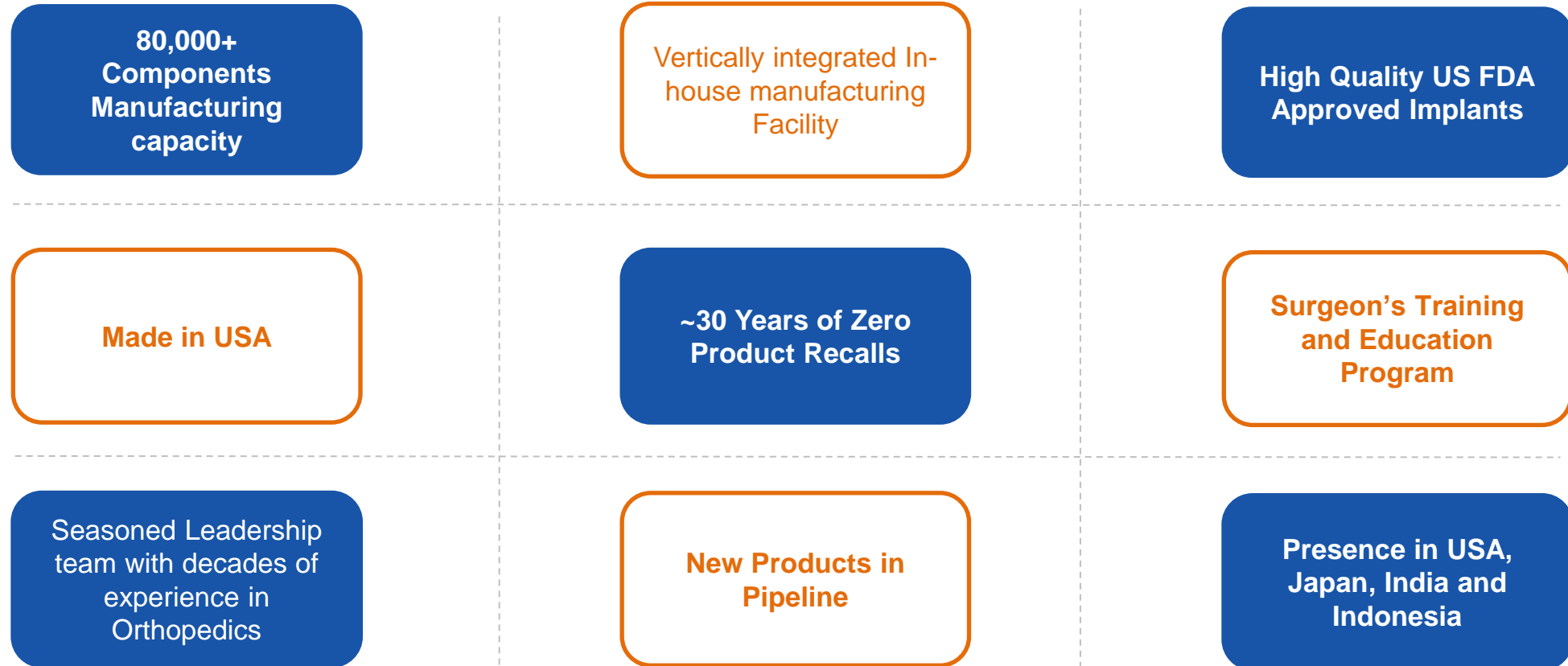
